

Information obligation

Fulfilling the obligation imposed on us under Art. 13 and 14 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27/04/2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, the free movement of such data and the repeal of directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as the GDPR), we inform that we are the controller of your personal data. III. Categories of processed personal data

We process the following personal data:

- First name and surname,
- Position,
- Email address,
- Telephone number.

IV. Purpose of the processing

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- For performance of an agreement concluded with you,
- For marketing and statistical purposes,
- For contact aimed at establishing cooperation.

V. Grounds for the processing

1. CONSENT (in accordance with Art. 6(1)(a) of the GDPR)

Your personal data is processed on the basis of the consent given to us.

2. AGREEMENT (in accordance with Art. 6(1)(b) of the GDPR)

Your personal data is processed on the basis of the agreement binding us.

3. LEGITIMATE INTEREST (in accordance with Art. 6(1)(f) of the GDPR)

Your personal data is processed on the basis of our legitimate interest.

- For analytical purposes [e.g. building knowledge of our customers and contractors, financial analysis of our company],
- For archiving (evidence) purposes as a part of pursuing our legitimate interest in securing information in case of a legal need to prove facts,
- To possibly determine, pursue or defend against claims,
- To survey customer satisfaction as a part of pursuing our legitimate interest in determining the quality of our service and the level of our customers' satisfaction with our products and services,
- To directly offer you (direct marketing) products and services of companies cooperating with us (our partners).

VI. Right to object

At any time, you have the right to object to the processing of personal data for the purposes set out above, pursuant to Art. 21 of the GDPR.

VII. Period of storage of data

Your personal data will be processed for the period necessary for performance of the provisions of the agreement, the period of having your consent and the period set forth in the applicable laws (e.g. tax or accounting regulations).

VIII. Data recipients

Your personal data may be disclosed to entities from our capital group, our partners and companies with which we cooperate combining products or services with. Your personal data may also be accessed by our subcontractors (processors), including

accounting firms, law firms, IT companies, claims adjusters, service providers as a part of claims settlements and marketing agencies.

IX. Rights of persons concerned by the data:

Pursuant to the GDPR, you have:

- a) The right to access your data and receive a copy of your data,
- b) The right to correct your data,
- c) The right to delete data and limit the processing of data,
- d) The right to object to the processing of data,
- e) The right to transfer data,
- f) The right to file a complaint with a supervising body (President of Personal Data Protection Office).

X. Information on the requirement/voluntary nature of the provision of data:

The provision of personal data is voluntary, yet it may be necessary for the conclusion of an agreement.

XI. Automatic decision-making

Your personal data will not be an object of automatic decision-making or profiling.

XII. Transferring data to a third country

Your personal data will not be transferred outside of the EU.

XIII. Source of data

If we did not receive your data directly from you, it was transferred to us by our business partner or contractor.
